Clinical Update: A new CMS regulation is being implemented related to the use of any Psychotropic Medications - including: an antidepressant, antianxiety, hypnotic and antipsychotic medications. A signed consent is now required PRIOR to the starting of one of these medications and PRIOR to any dose increase of these already started medications. With this new regulation, the nursing staff cannot administer any of these medications if newly ordered or dose increase (including some of those medications used with end-of-life care) without the signed consent. We know that his is going to be difficult and inconvenient at times for families of our residents; therefore, we want to visit with families about available options of obtaining your signature in a timely manner. Your loved one's care is important to use, and we want to partner with you to help facilitate this new requirement in the best way possible. Please feel free to call with any questions.
